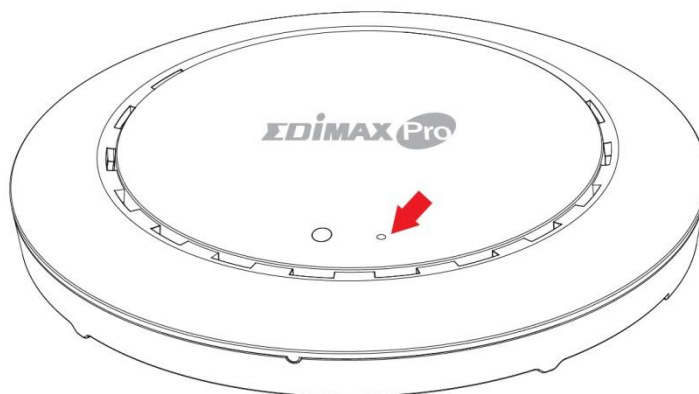
I-5 Кнопка Reset

Если у вас возникли проблемы с точкой доступа, вы можете сбросить настройки в заводские. При этом будут установлены все настройки по умолчанию.

1. Нажмите и удерживайте кнопку Reset не менее 10 секунд.



Вам нужно воспользоваться скрепкой или другим тонким предметом, чтобы нажать на кнопку reset.



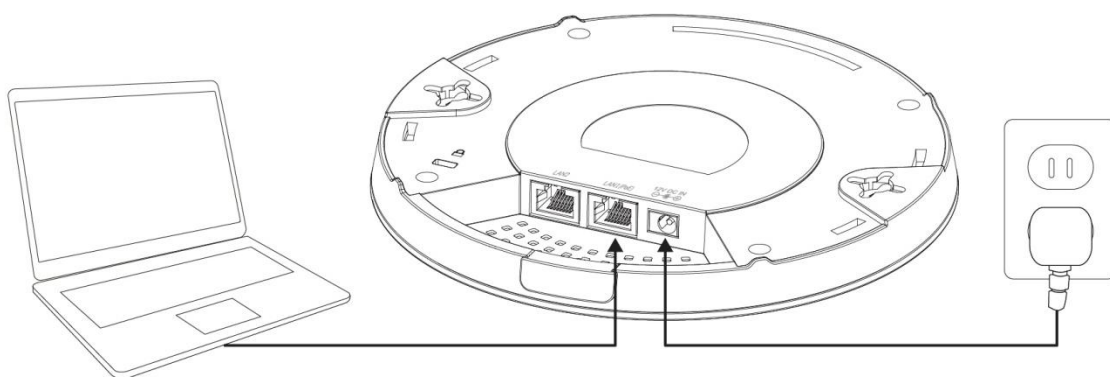

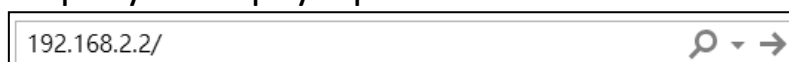
Ваша точка доступа может быть установлена и запущена в течении нескольких минут. Настоящая инструкция поможет вам установить точку доступа и выполнить базовые настройки конфигурации. Пожалуйста следуйте инструкциям, изложенным в разделах ниже.

II-1 Начальная установка

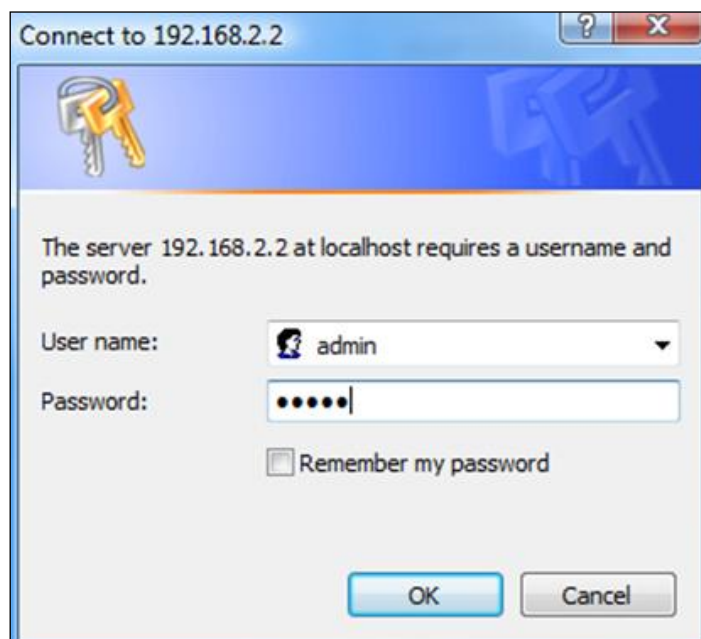
1. Присоедините точку доступа к компьютеру Ethernet кабелем.
2. Подключите адаптер питания к точке доступа и воткните его в электророзетку.



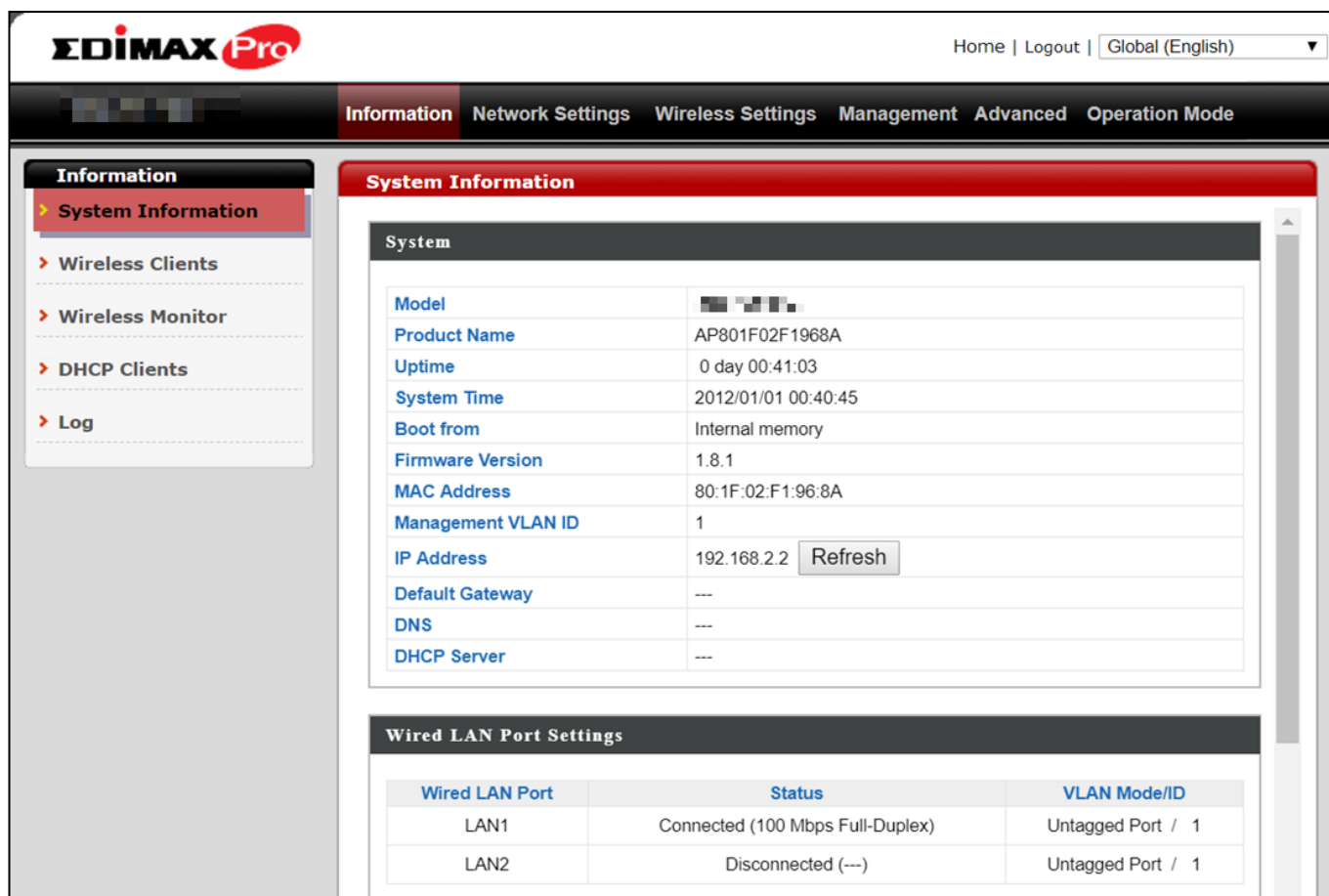
3. Пожалуйста, дождитесь окончания запуска точки доступа. Она будет готова к работе, когда LED индикатор загорится **голубым**.
4. Установите IP адрес компьютера **192.168.2.x** где **x** число в пределах **3 – 100**. Если вы не знаете как это сделать, пожалуйста прочитайте инструкцию пользователя.
 **Пожалуйста, убедитесь в отсутствии других активных сетевых подключений на вашем компьютере (отключите Wi-Fi связь и другие Ethernet кабели).**
5. Введите IP адрес точки доступа по умолчанию **192.168.2.2** в адресную строку веб браузера.



6. Появится окно ввода имени пользователя и пароля. Введите параметры по умолчанию: имя пользователя **“admin”** и пароль **“1234”**.



7. Откроется страница “System Information” как показано ниже:

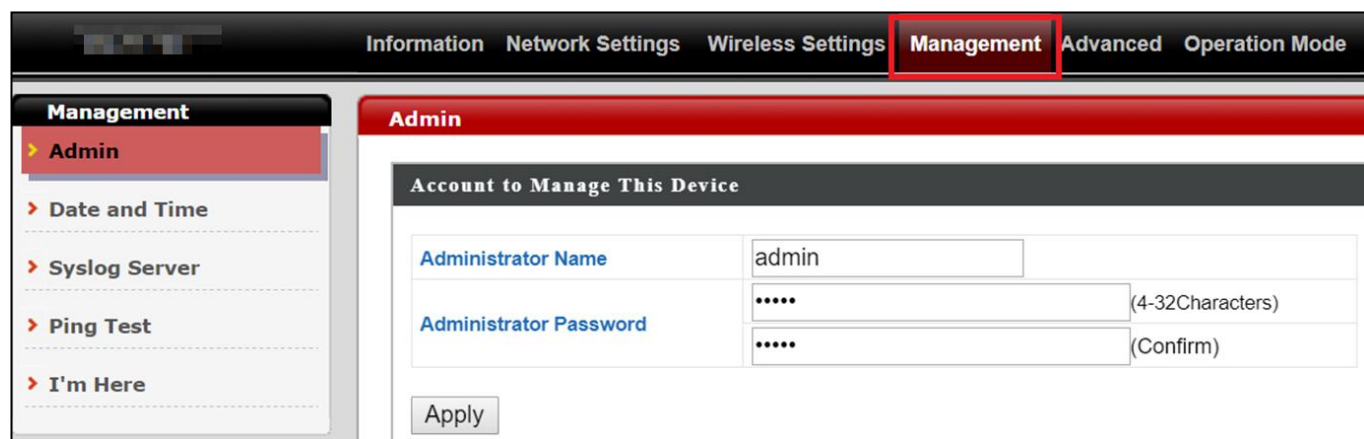

II-3 Wi-Fi Protected Setup (WPS)

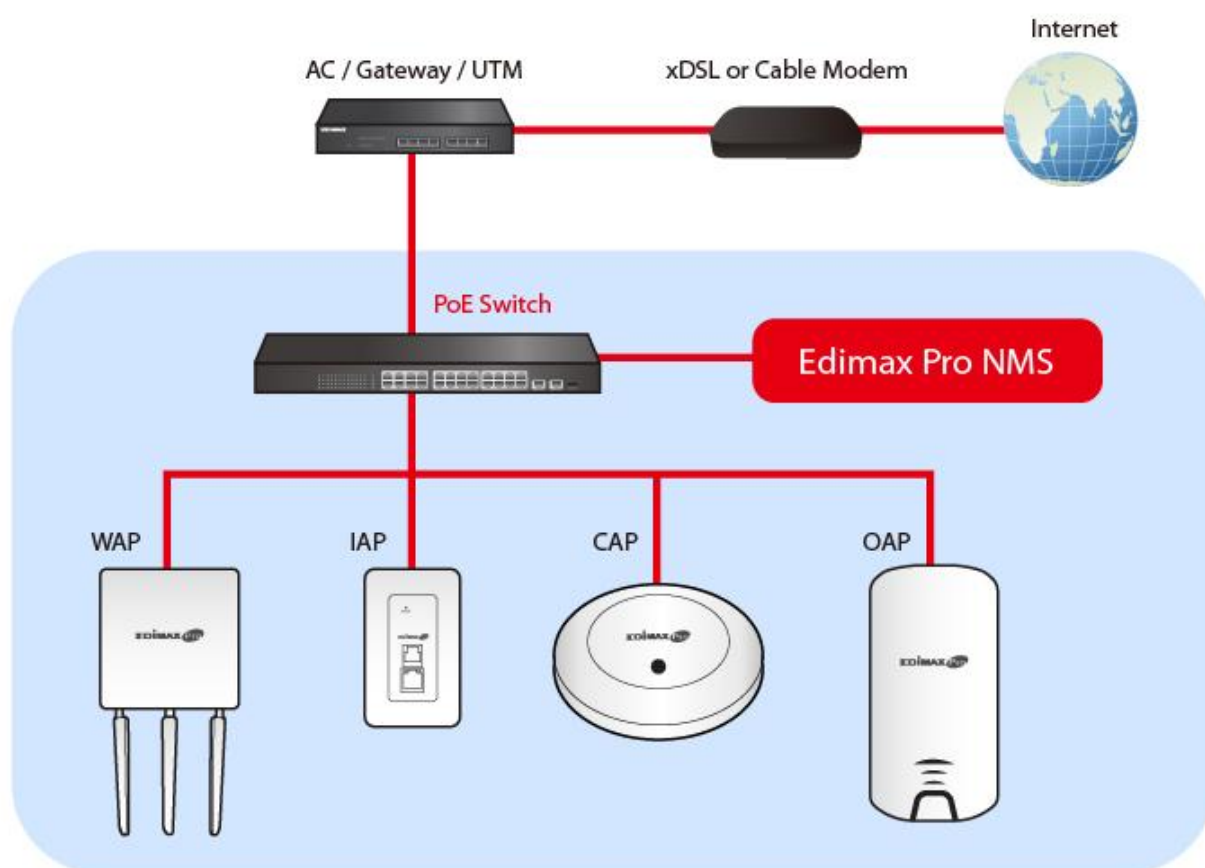
Wi-Fi Protected Setup это простой способ подключить устройство к сети с WPS поддержкой. Вы можете пользоваться WPS кнопку или конфигурацию на веб странице для активации WPS функции.

1. Перейдите **“Wireless Settings” > “WPS”** на странице конфигурации.
2. Нажмите кнопку **“Enable”** и нажмите **“Apply”** для активации WPS функции.
3. В течение 2 минут, активируйте WPS на вашем маршрутизаторе или другом устройстве с поддержкой WPS. Пожалуйста проверьте документы как активировать WPS на вашем устройстве.
4. Обе устройства установит соединение.

III Быстрая установка - NMS

Edimax Pro Network Management Suite (NMS) поддерживает центральное управление группой точек доступа, иначе известную как ТД-массив. NMS может быть установлена на одной точке доступа и поддерживает до 16 точек доступа Edimax Pro без необходимости дополнительного беспроводного контроллера, так вы можете снизить затраты и эффективно управлять всеми точками доступа в вашей системе.

Edimax Pro NMS прост в настройке. Ниже представлен обзор системы:



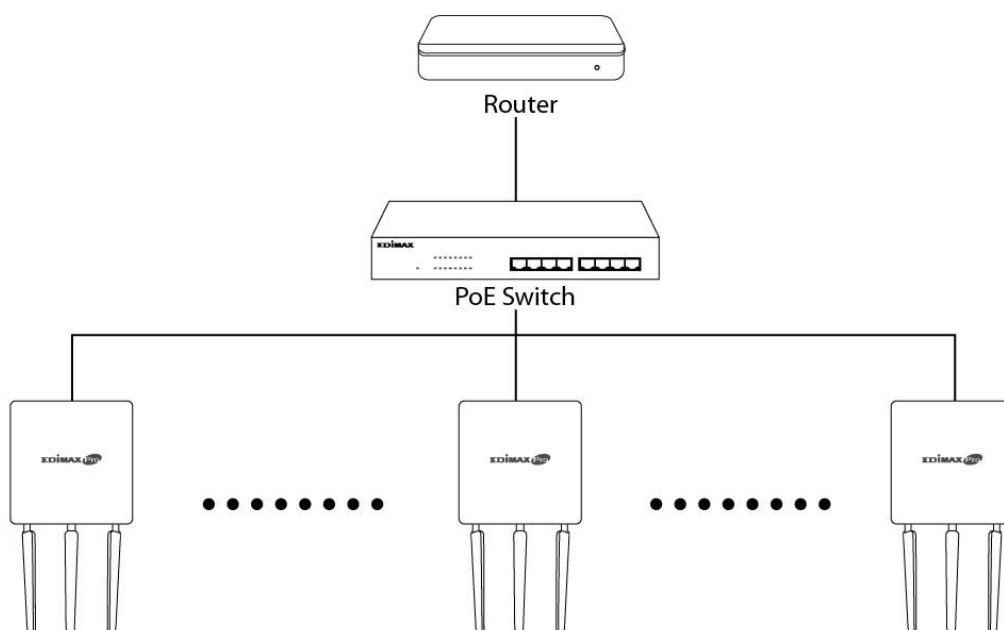

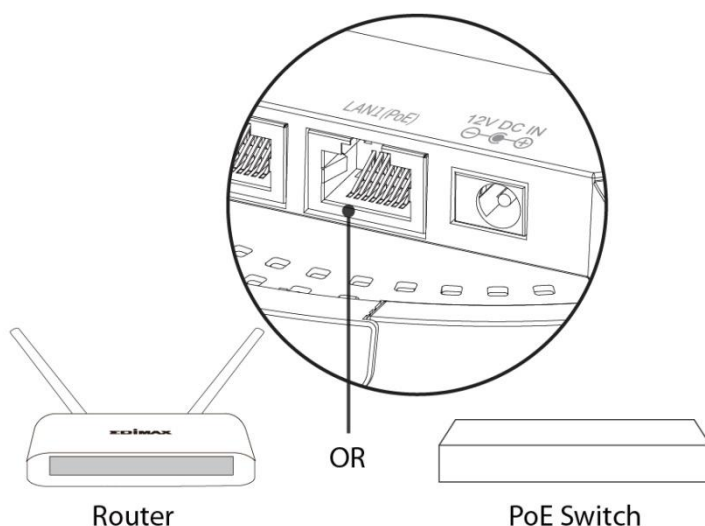
IV Установка устройства

IV-1 Маршрутизатор/PoE коммутатор

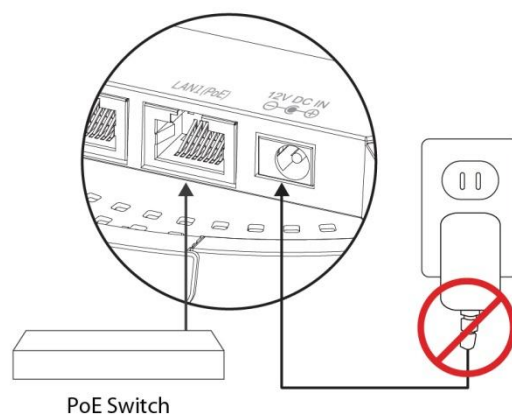
1. Если вам нужно, удалите защитный пластик на точке доступа. Это делает больше площади для установки кабелей.



2. Подключите маршрутизатор или коммутатор PoE к порту LAN 1 точки доступа с помощью кабеля Ethernet.



3. Подключите питание:
 - а) Если используется маршрутизатор, подключите адаптер питания к разъему 12 В постоянного тока точки доступа и подключите адаптер питания к источнику питания; или
 - б) Если PoE (Power over Ethernet) коммутатор используется, убедитесь, что кабель Ethernet подключен к порту LAN1 от коммутатора. Точка доступа будет питаться от коммутатора PoE.





Не используйте адаптер питания, если вы используете переключатель PoE.

- 4.** Подключите клиент локальной сети или переключитесь на порт LAN 2 точки доступа по мере необходимости.
